CHAPTER 22.02
DIRECTOR OF AUDIT (PRESCRIBED AGE) ACT

AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION RELATING TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF AUDIT.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Director of Audit (Prescribed Age) Act.

Tenure of office of Director of Audit.

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law and subject to the provisions of the Constitution of the State, the Director of Audit shall hold office until he or she attains the age of fifty-five years:

Provided that—

- (a) he or she may at any time resign his or her office by writing under his or her hand addressed to the Governor-General; and
 - (b) the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the recommendation of the Public Service Commission may permit a Director of Audit to continue in office after attaining the age prescribed in this Act for a period or periods not exceeding in the aggregate five years.
- (2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall not apply to a person appointed to act as Director of Audit in respect of his or her acting appointment.
