CHAPTER 23.02
BASSETERRE LIMITS ACT

AN ACT TO DEFINE THE LIMITS OF BASSETERRE.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Basseterre Limits Act.

Boundaries of Town of Basseterre.

2. The town of Basseterre shall be taken and considered to include all the land lying between and within the lines to be drawn or considered as drawn in the following manner, viz., beginning at the east end from a point on the sea shore lying due south of the boundary line between the Pond Estate and the public land lately part of the Lucas Estate and running thence in a straight line due north to the point lying due east of the northern side of the path running east and west and leading along by the north side of the Moravian Church towards the Taylor's Estate; and beginning at the west end from a point on the sea shore lying due south of the boundary line between the La Guerite and Buckleys Estates, and running thence in a straight line due north to a point lying due west of the said northern side of the said path leading along by the north side of the Moravian Church and thence running due east until it meets the northern side of the said path leading along by the north side of the Moravian Church as aforesaid, the boundary on the south of the town of Basseterre being the sea; and the bounds and limits of the town of Basseterre shall from henceforth be taken and considered according to the lines to be drawn in the manner aforesaid with the sea as the southern boundary as hereinbefore mentioned.
