CHAPTER 24.13

VALLEY BAPTIST CHURCH ST. KITTS INCORPORATION ACT

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCORPORATION OF THE VALLEY BAPTIST CHURCH, SAINT KITTS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED OR INCIDENTAL MATTERS.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts Incorporation Act.

Incorporation of Valley Baptist Church.

2. The Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts, shall be a body corporate, and shall, in its corporate name—
 - (a) have perpetual succession;
 - (b) be capable of suing and being sued in a court of law;
 - (c) have a common seal;
 - (d) be capable of acquiring property by purchase, exchange, demise or otherwise, in perpetuity or for the life or lives for any term of years or upon any other terms, conditions or limitations.

Vesting of property in the Valley Baptist Church.

3. (1) Any property that belonged to or was held in trust for or on behalf of the Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts prior to the coming into force of this Act is hereby vested in the Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts.

(2) The Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts may, subject to the rules and regulations made under this Act acquire by purchase, exchange, demise or otherwise, lands or property, in perpetuity or for the life or lives for any term of years or upon any other terms, conditions or limitations.

Power to dispose of property.

4. The Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts, may, subject to the rules and regulations made under this Act, from time to time by deed under its seal, sell or

demise, grant, convey, exchange or otherwise dispose of any land or other property vested in the Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts, as it sees fit.

Saving.

5. Nothing in this Act shall affect the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors or any body politic or corporate or any other person except such as are mentioned in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.

Power of the Church to make Regulations.

6. The Valley Baptist Church, Saint Kitts may, with the approval of the Minister responsible for ecclesiastical affairs, make regulations to manage its affairs.
