## SAINT CHRISTOPHER AND NEVIS

### No. 17 of 2020

AN ACT to provide for the services of Saint Christopher and Nevis for the financial year commencing 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021 and ending on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021.

*[Published 29<sup>th</sup> December 2020, Extra Ordinary Gazette No. 94 of 2020.]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Saint Christopher and Nevis and by the authority of the same as follows:—

#### **1. Short title and commencement.**

This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (2021) Act, 2020 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January, 2021.

#### **2. Appropriation.**

There shall be and there is hereby granted to Her Majesty the Queen for and during the period of one year commencing from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2021 and ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 2021, the sum of Seven Hundred and Seventy Million, One Hundred and Thirty-Six Thousand and Fifty-Three Dollars (\$770,136,053) over and above the sums granted and provided under the Acts and other laws in force in Saint Christopher and Nevis, to be applied and expended in the manner and the services set forth in the Schedule hereto.

#### **3. Sums charged on Consolidated Fund.**

The said sum of Seven Hundred and Seventy Million, One Hundred and Thirty-Six Thousand and Fifty-Three Dollars (\$770,136,053), shall be and the same is hereby declared to be charged upon and payable from and out of the Consolidated Fund.

#### **4. Authority to pay.**

The Accountant General of Saint Christopher and Nevis is hereby authorised and required from time to time upon the order or warrant of the Minister of Finance to pay the several services therein mentioned, as the said order or warrant shall direct, out of the Consolidated Fund without further order or formality.
