AN ACT to amend the Liquor Licences Act, Cap. 18.21.

[Published 21st February 2020, Extra-Ordinary Gazette No. 13 of 2020.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Saint Christopher and Nevis and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Short title.

This Act may be cited as the Liquor Licences (Amendment) Act, 2020.

2. Interpretation.

In this Act,

“Act” means the Liquor Licences Act, Cap. 18.21.

3. Amendment of Section 4.

The Act is amended in section 4 by adding a new subsection (3) as follows

“(3). Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Minister may by Order published in the Gazette appoint a day or days for the holding of an additional special sitting of the Magistrate’s Court for the purposes of subsection (1).
