**WHEREAS** it is proposed to observe annually the commemoration of a Day to celebrate the lives and contribution of our Centenarians

**AND WHEREAS** it is proposed to observe Sunday the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2020 as Centenarians Day to recognize our Centenarians in the Federation of Saint Christopher and Nevis

**NOW THEREFORE, I, Sir Samuel Weymouth Tapley Seaton**, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Queen's Counsel, Justice of the Peace, Doctor of Laws, Governor-General of the Federation of Saint Christopher and Nevis, in exercise of all powers me thereunto enabling and in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet **DO HEREBY** declare that Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2020 be observed as Centenarians Day

**AND** all our officers and loving subjects in Saint Christopher and Nevis and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.



**GIVEN** under my hand and the Public Seal of Saint Christopher and Nevis at Government House this 26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2020, and in the sixty-ninth year of Her Majesty's reign.
