Liquor Licences (Special Court) Order, 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Liquor Licences Act, Cap. 18.21, the Minister makes the following Order:

1. Citation.

This Order may be cited as the Liquor Licences (Special Court) Order, 2020.

2. Interpretation.

In this Order, “Act” means the Liquor Licences Act, Cap. 18.21, as amended by Act, No. 5 of 2020.

3. Date of Additional Special Court.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 4 of the Act, the Minister hereby appoints the 28th day of February, 2020 for the holding of an additional special sitting of the Magistrate’s Court and each Magistrate shall hold a special Court in his or her district for the purpose of

- (a) receiving and considering the applications of persons for licences; or
- (b) the renewal of licences,

to sell intoxicating liquors within that district, whether by wholesale or retail.
