**WHEREAS** it is enacted by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act (Chapter 23.23) that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General, on the advice of the Cabinet, to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Saint Christopher and Nevis or in any island, town, district or village thereof:

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor-General, on the advice of the Cabinet of Saint Christopher and Nevis considers it expedient that Tuesday the 4<sup>th</sup> day of August 2020 should be observed and kept as a public holiday in Saint Christopher and Nevis on the occasion of the virtual celebration of Culturama:

**NOW THEREFORE, I, SIRSAMUEL WEYMOUTH TAPLEY SEATON**, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Queen's Counsel, Justice of the Peace, Doctor of Laws, Governor-General of the Federation of Saint Christopher and Nevis do with the advice of the Cabinet, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by the said section of the said Act, appoint Tuesday the 4<sup>th</sup> day of August 2020, to be reserved and kept as a public holiday in Saint Christopher and Nevis

**AND** all Our Officers and loving subjects in Saint Christopher and Nevis and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.



**GIVEN** under my hand and the Public Seal of Saint Christopher and Nevis at Government House, this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July 2020 and in the sixty-ninth year of Her Majesty's reign.
